AP US Government The US Constitution Study Guide. A representative must be 25 years old to be elected, be a citizen of the U.S. for 7 years, and can not when elected be an Inhabitant of that State in which they shall be chosen. Grants Congress the power to amend the Constitution, if necessary, if 1/3 of Congress agrees OR. 2/3 of the states can call a convention for proposing amendments. Article VI. The Constitution is the law of the land. All treaties, laws, and rulings will be the supreme law, which no state law or otherwise can contradict. The first ten amendments to the Constitution, the Bill of Rights protect citizens from the will of the majority. In other words, no majority could vote to take these rights away.
