Born two centuries ago, Ada Lovelace was a pioneer of computing science. She took part in writing the first published program and was a computing visionary, recognizing for the first time that computers could do much more than just calculations. Eratosthenes' friend, the great Archimedes, entrusted him with an enormously important treatise called The Method. In addition to containing the most advanced mathematics the world had ever seen, The Method gives us some clues about Eratosthenes' interests. Archimedes writes (loosely translated): In a November, 1999 article in the Honolulu Star-Bulletin, Burl Burlingame wrote, "Hawaiian culture, largely repressed at the beginning of the century in favor of Western education, began a comeback in the 1960's and is in full flower today.
