The next in Citroën's line of large family autos after the Xantia, the Citroën C5 has been produced in France since 2000, with two generations currently out (as of 2019) and a third generation expected in 2020. The Citroën C5 is a large family car produced by the French manufacturer Citroën since March 2001, and now in its second generation. The C5 replaced the Citroën Xantia, in the large family car class. It is not the first Citroën with "Cx" naming nomenclature, as it was used by its ancestors, the C4 and C6 from 1930. The third generation is expected to be released in 2020. The popularity of French automobiles may not be at the high point now that it was in the early stages of the last century, but even with the advances made by other nations, there are still several brands which owe either their existence or a significant element of their popularity to the nation. New C5 Aircross SUV offers a broad range of personalisation options. These include 30 exterior combinations, with seven body colours (Polar White, Nera Black, Platinum Grey, Steel Grey, Volcano Red, Tijuca Blue, Pearl White) and three anodised Colour Packs (Silver, White and Red).
