These guidelines for coding and reporting have been developed and approved by the The ICD-10-CM system of coding contains approximately 68,000 codes and these codes become essential when claiming for any type of health insurance in the U.S. If we compare ICD-9-CM, we find very few alterations are done with ICD-10-CM Draft code set for 2013 which will be in effect from 1st October 2014.
